# Pastor's Report

Pastor suggests that Council members send him their suggestions.

Mike said Property Committee would like to update the sign below the church on Clayton Road, and maybe we could incorporate a new logo onto this wooden sign.

# **Committee Reports**

#### Finance - Laura Mott

- Laura reported we are down approximately \$7,000, mostly from investments and facility use. However, spending is also down, which is helpful. We expect by the end of the year the loss will be made up.
- We are still waiting for the PPP loan decision to be received from the SBA.
- Waiting for the Sabbatical grant decision, so the Finance Team can create the financing plan.

#### **Evangelism – Sue Hertless**

Sue reported Pastor Christian Chavarria will be visiting Good Shepherd from September 3-11. He will be preaching a sermon on September 5, giving a presentation on "The Ministry of the El Salvador Lutheran Church" at 12 noon, with a lunch at 1 PM. Sue said Synod churches and local churches have received invitations to attend. Those attending must RSVP to have an accurate count. Pastor Christian is representing Bishop Medardo, as he cannot come due to health issues.

# **Property and Long-Range Planning – Mike Henry**

- Mike reported the team's projects are all slow-moving projects at this point. Mike feels he
  will have more information for Council at next month's meeting, and hopefully have motions
  ready to be voted on to move some projects forward.
- Mike reported AT&T would like to do a site survey and have us sign an application form for the City of Concord to replace their antenna equipment – they assured us there is no new look to that, other than it will be newer equipment.

### Social Ministry - Scott Etzel

 Scott reported the blood drive is still scheduled for this month, and that we need more people to sign up.
